

Documents And Information For The Signing Of The Purchase Promise And Purchase Contract

Individuals

Dominicans (Nationals/Locals):

- Full name, current physical address, telephone, and email of the Buyer.
- If employed, the name of the company and its address.
- Clear and valid copies of both sides of the Buyer's National ID Card. If the ID indicates marital status as married, clear and valid copies of both sides of the ID of the spouse are required, who must jointly sign the Purchase Promise and the Purchase Contract. If the Buyer's ID indicates married status but the actual status is single, the original of the Divorce Certificate must be requested.
- If the Buyer has a representative, the original of the Power of Attorney duly legalized by a Notary Public.

Foreigners:

- Full name, current physical address, telephone, and email of the Buyer.
- If employed, the name of the company and its address.
- Clear and valid copy of the Passport or Residence Card of the Buyer.
- If the Buyer has a representative, the original of the Power of Attorney duly legalized by a Notary Public.
- For two or more Buyers, request the same documents as indicated above.
- Optional Documents: Employment letter and Certificate of No Criminal Record issued by the Attorney General's Office of the Dominican Republic.
